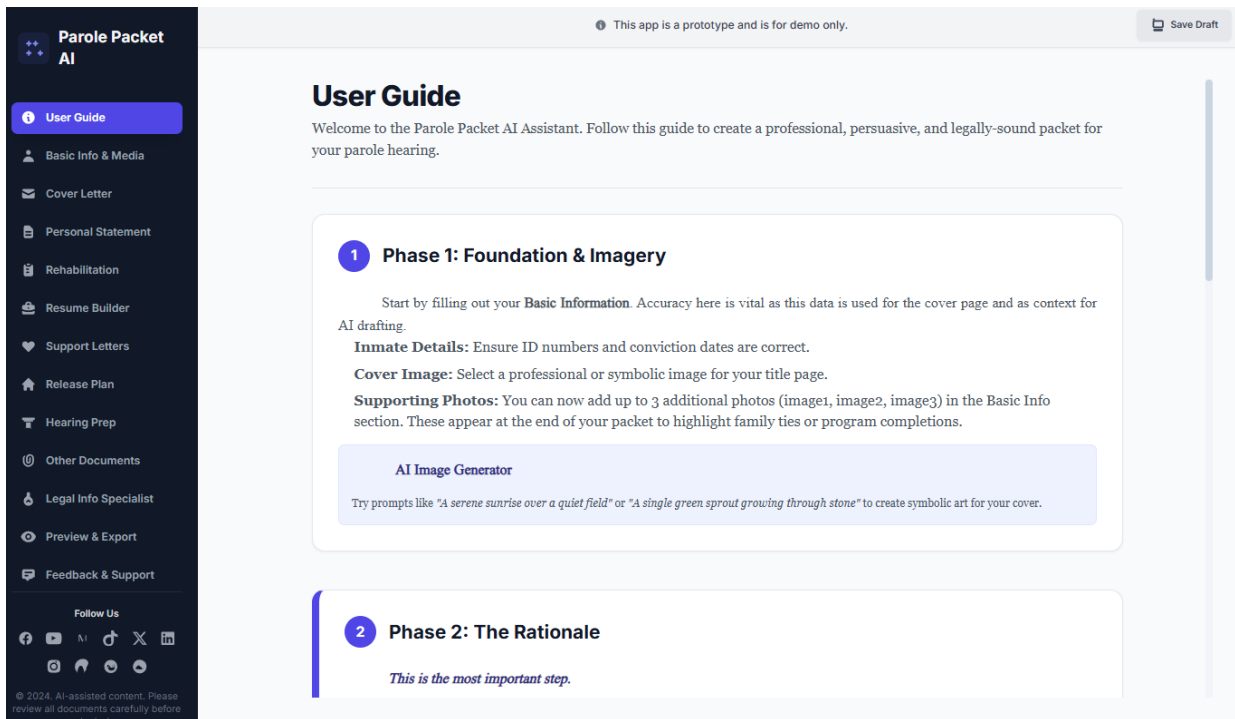
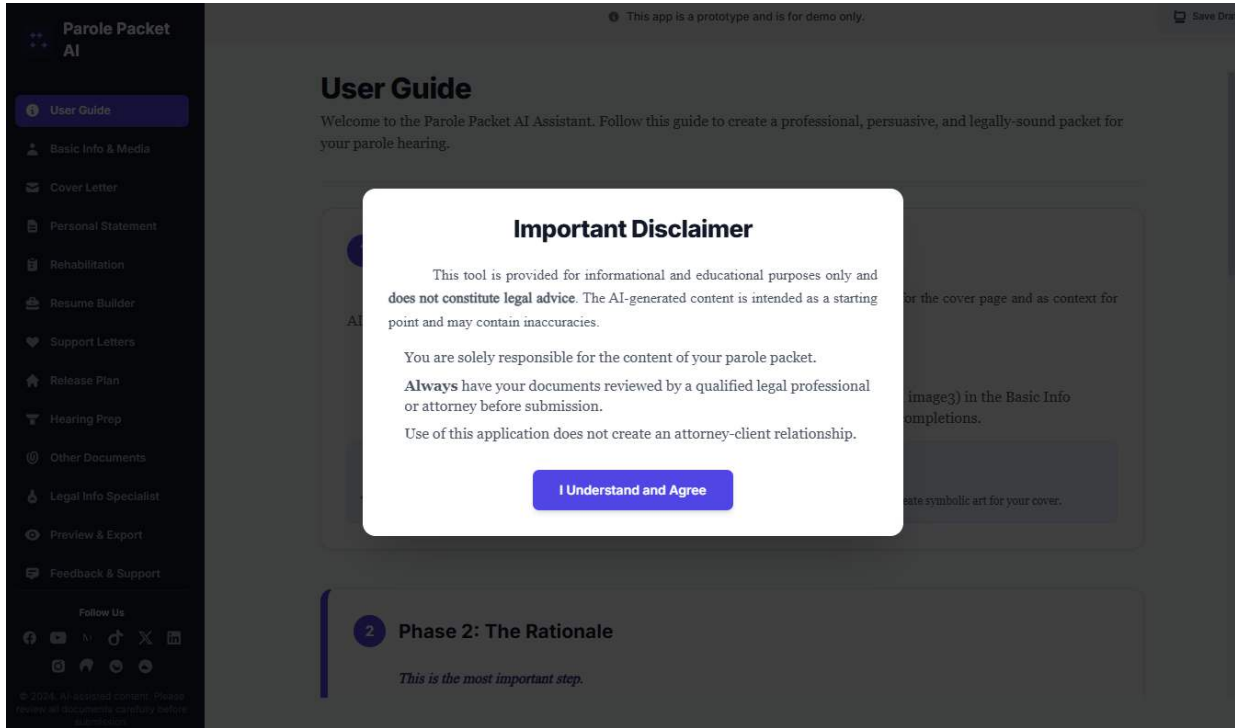

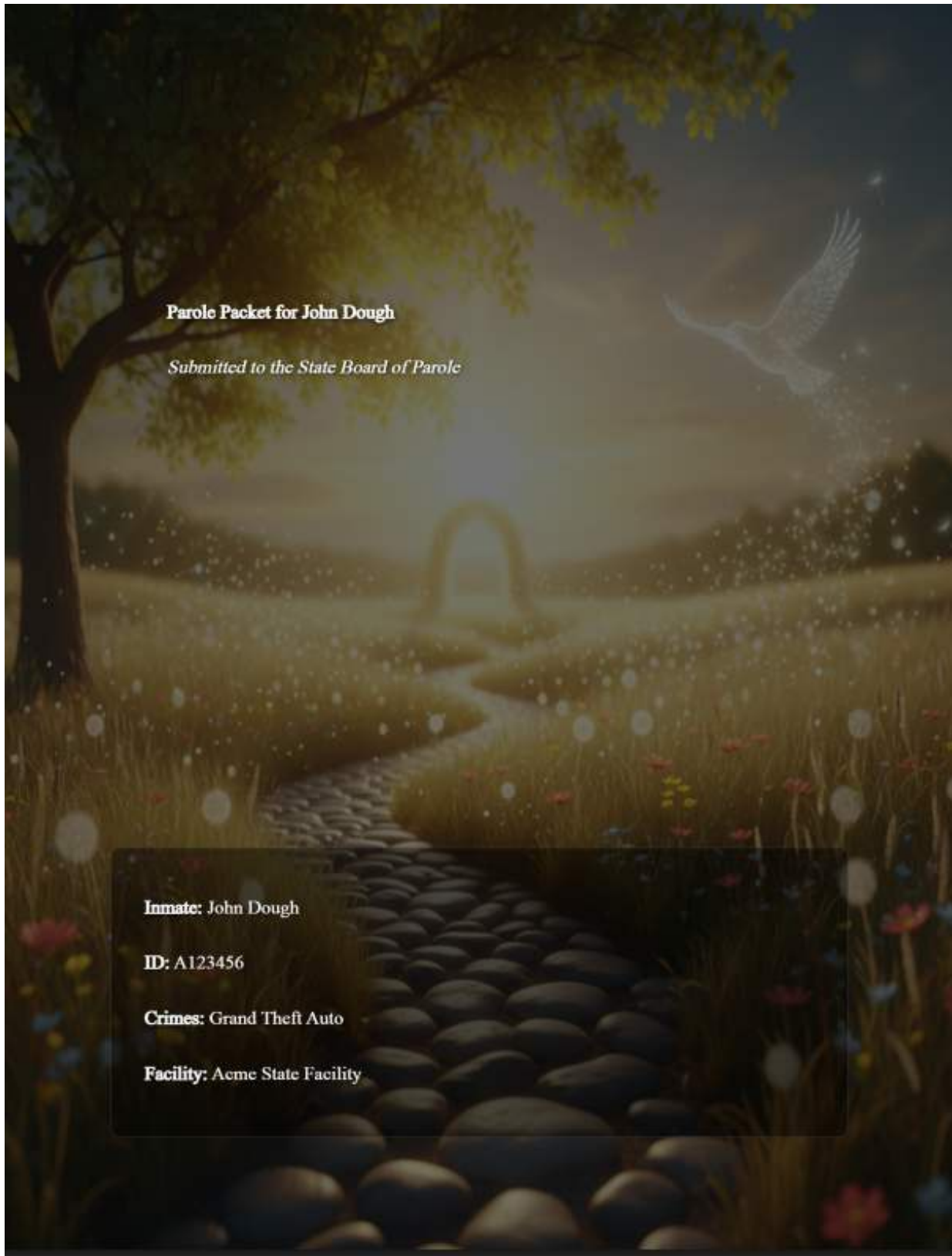

Beyond vocational skills, I have dedicated myself to emotional rehabilitation. Through counseling, I learned to control my anger and utilize breathing techniques that allow me to think before acting. I did not just learn these skills in theory; I put them to the test. Using VR simulators, I practiced these techniques while being triggered in virtual scenarios, and I continue to practice them on occasion during my daily life in prison.

Today, I am learning to be a responsible man. I have learned to forgive myself, and through restorative circles, I have humbly asked my victims to forgive me. I have learned to be fully accountable for my decisions, whether they are good or bad. I know that words are not enough, which is why I try to make amends for the pain I caused by paying into the victims' advocacy fund.

I am no longer the reckless man I was when I entered these walls. I am becoming a better man every day, preparing for a future outside of prison where I can apply my skills as a carpenter and live as a responsible, law-abiding citizen. I respectfully ask for the opportunity to prove this to you.
